All About Me Unit

There isn't a better time to learn about children and their families than in our "All About Me" unit. Our art area is a busy place! Watch for body tracings, hand and foot print murals, paper plate faces and silhouettes.

We love to graph! We'll graph the number of boys versus the number of girls, hair color, eye color, and the number of family members. We'll make a growth chart and measure our height and weight.

In language, our preschoolers will make "me books" by cutting out pictures of favorite foods, pets, family members, houses and cars. We'll talk all about our families. ***Please bring in family photos for our family bulletin board!***

Our budding architects, designers, and builders will keep our block area lively building houses, neighborhoods, schools, and roads. They'll build buildings as tall as they are and count

how many blocks are used to determine their height.

We have some interesting activities planned for the science and discovery area. The children will make hand prints and look at all the lines and skin patterns. We'll record our voices and listen to them. "Is that really me?"

We'll carry our "All About Me" activities to our sensory tables. The children will wash the plastic babies and dishes and even make hand prints in the sand!

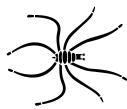
INFANTS & TODDLERS
